The Structure of the Gala

Classification

Briefly, swimmers have been classified by their clubs as

Group A Disability that does not affect swimming strokes

Group B Disability that does affect swimming strokes, but can participate with minimum assistance

Group C Very severe disability (carers allowed in the water)

Seeding

Swimmers have been seeded to give a competitive swim. There are no finals and so swimmers in races with heats should be aware that medals are awarded on a time basis. There are gold, silver and bronze medals for each race number.

<u>Strokes</u>

Front: Any stroke on the front (ie backstroke is not allowed - it is not a freestyle race).

Back: Any stroke on the back. Please remind swimmers to stay on their backs until the very end of the race.
