ELIGIBILITY This Short Course licenced (applied for) competition is open to any swimmer with a disability (physical, sensory or learning) but created for **swimmers in regular training with an understanding of the rules of competitive swimming** (which will be applied) to enable them to compete for age group event medals and gain times in a prestigious competition including relays and for East Midlands swimmers to compete for overall age group awards.

If swimmers or clubs are unsure if this event is appropriate for them to enter then please contact the event coordinator.

NON EAST MIDLANDS SWIMMERS are very welcome to enter this event. Should entries exceed the capacity of the pool then Swimmers from within the East Midlands will take preference. **NOTE** Only those swimmers who individually or by virtue of the club they compete for are within the East Midlands geographical area will be eligible for regional awards.

MEMBERSHIP This is a Swim England event and swimmers should hold an appropriate Swim England membership and enter their number on the entry form. If anyone has a query or needs any help in this area then please contact the event organiser. Temporary Swim England membership application will be accepted for this event at an additional cost of £10.00. Download complete and return application form with entry.

REFRESHMENTS There is a cafeteria available in the leisure centre but please be aware that the cafeteria will be busy at the lunch break.

LUNCH We are not offering swimmers lunch, therefore teams are reminded to ensure that swimmers bring appropriate food with them.

EPILEPSY Swimmers with epilepsy should ensure that their entry form is ticked and that the lifeguards are made aware of this before each of their races. A responsible adult who knows the swimmers condition should accompany them. This person must act as a "spotter" on the poolside while the swimmer is in the water.

POOLSIDE ACCESS PLEASE ENSURE THAT TEAMS / COACHES APPLY FOR PASSES WITH YOUR ENTRY FORM cost **£5.00 each**. Only team managers, coaches and support staff that have poolside passes should access the poolside. Access will be strictly monitored. Passes can be requested at £5.00 per pass (includes a programme) and can be collected on the day of competition. All requests for passes must be accompanied by a completed self-declaration **- form B**

<u>ENTRY FEES</u> The non-refundable entry fee is a flat £16.00 per swimmer NOT per event. Please ensure that the correct fee is sent with your entry.

Please note that the venue, changing rooms and community pool at Braunstone will remain open to the public during the event. Lockers take 10p coins. Clubs are reminded to ensure that they supervise their swimmers appropriately at all times.

RULES This competition takes place under the laws of Disability Sport Events / Activity Alliance who have adopted the <u>Paralympic Rules</u> with some additions except where amended by these Promoters Conditions

TEAM MANAGERS AND SWIMMERS ARE ASKED TO ENSURE THAT THEY ARE FULLY CONVERSANT WITH ALL STROKE RULES APLICABLE TO THEIR DISABILITY AND TO ENSURE THAT SWIMMERS ARE NOT ENTERED FOR STROKES THAT THEY CANNOT LEGALLY DO. This competition is intended for swimmers who understand the rules of competitive swimming.

CLASSIFICATION

Swimmers should note their entry **form A** with their classification if they have one, or note that they are awaiting classification. Ideally all eligible swimmers should have a classification. We understand however that the opportunities for swimmers to be formally classified are limited and that classification is inappropriate or unavailable for some disability swimmers. We will not automatically exclude swimmers without a formal classification. **Swimmers without a formal classification** should annotate their entry form with a note of their disability. Swimmers with a learning disability who have downs syndrome should also note their entry form so their times can be compared to a more appropriate data base.

<u>RACES</u> All individual races will be made up of people with similar entry times, irrespective of their age, sex or disability. This makes races as competitive as possible and helps swimmers to gain fast times.

Medals and awards are not made according to position in each race heat but according to the points a swimmers time achieves when compared to others of the same age group.

It is important that accurate times are submitted for all events. If no time is completed a swimmer may be automatically placed in the fastest / slowest race. Swimmers with times on Swim England rankings will have those times automatically entered as their entry time, unless specific mention to use alternative is made on their entry form.

RELAYS Relay Events will be formalised when the range of entrants has been reviewed. Teams will generally be organised as county / regional teams. Swimmers names will be forwarded to the relay organiser who will select teams for each of the relays. Swimmers from outside the East Midlands will also be included in relays.

AWARDS

Certificates will be awarded to all participants recording, where appropriate, their individual times medals in each of their events.

A swimmers individual race time is compared to the East Midlands disability swimming points data base* to convert their swim performance into a points score.

Event Medals 1st 2nd 3rd place medals will be awarded to recognise points performance **within each age group for each event** eg.one 1st 2nd 3rd medal is awarded within the Boys aged 13/14 competing the 50m Freestyle (comparing swims across all heats).

East Midlands Awards (only for East Midlands swimmers) Points from a swimmers **4 highest eligible swims** are added together to make awards to the First and Second highest overall scorers in each age group.

Awards are NOT made for each race as swum because each heat is primarily made up of swimmers with similar entry times. Therefore swimmers racing against each other in a heat may be very dissimilar in age sex or impairment.

Points and therefore medal awards can generally only be made where an event has an international short course record for a swimmer with their impairment e.g. 25m events are not offered at international level so medals will not be routinely awarded, however see **discretionary** awards.

Discretionary awards Medals or other appropriate recognition of a performance, such as achievement of a personal best time, may be made entirely at the discretion of the organisers.

Ages for awards and in programme will be as at December 31st 2019

Age groups Age groups used at this event will be 10, 11/12, 13/14, 15/16, 17/18 and 19 and over (age as at December 31st 2019) Minimum age for entry is aged 10 on or before December 31st 2019.

^{*}Our data base is compiled from various sources such as IPC and Downs world records and bespoke times to enable as fair a comparison as possible of one swimmers performance with another taking account the swimming impairment of each competitor. Every effort is made to include an appropriate target time for all swimmers regardless of whether or not they have a formal swimming classification.

EVENT SELECTION Coaches and team managers are kindly asked to consider carefully before deciding which events to put swimmers in. To think about what is appropriate for their individual competition pathway as well as fair to both them and their fellow competitors. This event fulfils a developmental role, is a prestigious competition and an opportunity to swim events swimmers may not normally have access to. As a general rule: 25m events are intended for unclassified young swimmers or those with greater physical impairments and as noted medals are not automatically awarded for these events: 50m events are intended for younger, less experienced or class 1-5 swimmers. This general guidance is not intended to prevent swimmers who may not yet be capable of racing 50m in a particular stroke from entering the 25m for race experience and you are encouraged to contact the organiser if unsure. The organisers would not wish to impose strict rules on which events can be entered by whom but we do rely on the good sense of entrants to make the event a positive experience for all. Swimmers are strongly recommended to enter no more than 3 individual events in each session.

Individual Medley Swimmers are permitted to enter only one of the individual medley distances.

Swimmers should remember that **only points scored from a maximum of 4 eligible individual events will count towards the East Midlands regional age group awards**.

<u>Classification information</u> For swimmers who wish to compete in disability swimming competitions at National / International level
